



Jewish People's Declaration of Independence

A Proclamation of Disengagement From Any Policy Which Would Compromise the Defense and Survival of the Sovereign Nation of Israel

Israel, unlike any other democracy in the world, has an obligation that she must honor that is no less sacred in its decree than that which consecrates Liberty's just purpose and cause. It is the pledge that, *never again* will the Jewish People be victims of a Holocaust perpetrated by those whose mandate of hate would cause them to abandon their own humanity in pursuit of absolute power and/or world domination.

This is why Israel, in the name of the victims and survivors of the Holocaust, and as a freedom-loving people, must never be bound to any agreement which would hand over any land for the promise of a "peaceful" co-existence with nations and people who embrace tyranny and fascism as their protocol, or adhere to any requests from those in the international community who would ask her to show restraint in the face of an impending nuclear holocaust.
